

TS PECET-2022 ADMISSIONS

CERTIFICATES TO BE UPLOADED AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION AND FILLING APPLICATION FORM

1. Memorandum of marks of SSC/10th/ or equivalent.
2. Memorandum of marks of Intermediate/10+2/ or equivalent.
3. Memorandum of marks in Qualifying Examination (Degree). In case candidate is not having the minimum qualification marks in Degree then Memorandum of marks in PG Examination is required.
4. Provisional / Original Degree Certificate of Qualifying Examination. In case candidate is not having the minimum qualification marks in Degree then Provisional / Original PG Degree is required.
5. Study certificates from 9th class to Graduation.
6. Residence certificate for preceding 7 years of the qualifying examination i.e. Graduation in respect of candidates who have private study without any institutionalized education (Distance education/Open school education).
7. Residence certificate from M. R. O of either of parents in Telangana for 10 years in case of non-local candidates Residence certificate from M. R. O either of parents in Telangana for 10 years in case of non-local candidates.
8. In respect of Non-Local candidates in order to consider them for allotment under unreserved seats the following certificates need to be submitted.
 - a. **Residence Certificate:** Candidates who has resided in the State for a total period of 10 years excluding periods of study outside the State; or either of whose parents have resided in the State for a total period of 10 years excluding periods of employment outside the State.

(OR)

b. **Employer Certificate:** Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local bodies, Universities and other similar Quasi Public Institutions within the State at the time of applying for TS PECET- 2022 examination.

9. Transfer Certificate.
10. Latest Integrated community certificate issued by the competent authority in case of BC/SC/ST category candidates, if applicable.
11. Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) Reservation (applicable only to OC candidates): *As per the Guidelines issued in G.O.Ms.No.244, General Administration (SER.D) Department, Government of Telangana, dated. 24.08.2021, the 10% Reservation to the Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) in respect of Admissions into Educational Institutions shall be implemented. Candidates should produce EWS Certificate issued by MRO/ Tahsildar valid for the year **2022-23**
12. The Muslim and Christian Minority Candidates should upload the "TC" of the SSC containing Minority status (or) in the absence of TC, a Certificate issued by the Head of the Institution in which the student studied/appeared for SSC or its equivalent examination.
13. Special category certificates NCC / CAP
14. Latest Parental Income Certificate issued by M.R.O., Telangana Govt. after **01.01.2022**.
15. Aadhaar Card.
